THE SEMINAR

Be your own pilot in command

We intend to apply pilots' routines in other occupational fields as well. Specifically, we want to navigate skillfully, keep our focus on the horizon in times of great challenges and land at our desired destination safely.

Based on the methodology of pilots our seminar participants learn how to apply smart planning, clear communication, thoughtful and effective self-leadership and extensive debriefing to analyze weaknesses and improve strengths in their own professional environment. We focus on developing mental strength and self-empowerment in order to enable our participants to act with strong leadership skills, be target-oriented and efficient and to feel ready to face the daily challenges in their professional and private lives.

A flight simulator training in a Boeing 777 (with instruction, on same day) complements the seminar. The day concludes with an aperitif for all participants and speakers.



THE CORE POINTS

In the cockpit

- 1 FLIGHT PLAN** → A good plan is half the battle
- 2 EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED** → Training for and anticipating emergency situations
- 3 CHECKLIST PROCEDURES** → Structured procedures based on checklists
- 4 CLEARED TO LAND** → Clear communication
- 5 YOUR CONTROL, MY CONTROL** → Define responsibilities clearly
- 6 FOCUS ON YOUR HORIZON** → Stay on course, observe the general conditions, incorporate changes into the plan
- 7 MAKE A DECISION** → It's better to make a wrong decision than to make no decision
- 8 DEBRIEFING** → Error culture and continuous improvement


This seminar addresses everyone who wishes to acquire knowledge from the world of aviation and apply that to the work environment and for personal further education. It is particularly designed for:

THE METHODOLOGY

Flight route

The seminar starts with a theory session in plenum. Throughout the day, practical exercises in small groups and feedback sessions facilitate the transfer of knowledge into the professional environment. Various short lectures motivate participants to reach their own best flight level and to successfully complete their projects. The group will split up in the afternoon for a flight simulator training and more in-depth exercises.

SEMINAR 1

Learning from pilots for leaders

Components: Self-leadership skills, self-empowerment and resilience, communication competence, time management, stress management

Audience: people in a leadership position / female leaders

Goals: Participants acquire complementary knowledge and skills from the world of aviation to lead a company or team with purpose and efficiency

SEMINAR 2

Learning from Pilots for women back to business

Components: self-empowerment and resilience, communication competence, work-life-balance, time management, stress management

Audience: Women back to business

Goals: Participants strengthen their self-confidence and hone various skills to ease the re-entry into the working world

SEMINAR 3

Learning from pilots for project leaders (coming soon)

Components: effective transfer from the world of aviation to project management and project planning, time management, communication competence, debriefing methodology

Audience: Project leaders

Goals: Participants expand their knowledge and skills set regarding project management in order to organize projects with more focus, leadership and efficiency
